Veronika Bellova is a talented and accomplished Czech woman with a wide range of performing experience in acting, modeling, and music.

Ms. Bellova's acting credits include a variety of television, film and stage roles, for productions based in the United States, and Europe.

Highlights of her film roles include performances in the award-winning Czech film, "Kanarek" and in the internationally acclaimed director Vera Chytilova's film "Expulsion from Paradise". She played a mentally ill woman, Mugge, in the film "Rene Hjerter" by Danish director Kenneth Kainz, and the role of the Woman Captive in "Hannibal - Rising" directed by Peter Webber. Most recently she played Kazi - a key supporting role in the American film "The Pagan Queen" directed by Constantin Werner.

On US television Ms. Bellova appeared in the American mini-series "The Children of Dune" and the series "Revelations".

In advertising, Ms. Bellova's experience includes the lead in a popular TV and billboard campaign for Eurotel Telecommunications, and currently has been doing online video presentations for HSBC Bank, which regularly play on their website.

Ms. Bellova was born in the golden city of Prague, in the Czech Republic, where she currently resides. She has also spent considerable time in the United States.

In New York, Ms. Bellova studied with Tony and Marie Greco at The Film Center and at The Gregory Abels Training Ensemble. In London she completed coursework at ALRA, Academy of Live and Recorded Arts.
